१५ अगस्त १९४७ की आधी रात को भारत और पाकिस्तान कानूनी तौर पर दो स्वतंत्र राष्ट्र बने। लेकिन पाकिस्तान की सत्ता परिवर्तन की रस्मे १४ अगस्त को कराँची में की गई ताकि आखिरी ब्रिटिश वाइसरॉय लार्ड माउंटबेटन, कराँची और नई दिल्ली दोनों जगहों की रस्मों में हिस्सा ले सके। इसलिए पाकिस्तान में स्वतंत्रता दिवस १४ अगस्त और भारत में १५ अगस्त को मनाया जाता है।

परंतु आज भी अधिकांश युवाओं की अखंड भारत के स्वरूप व विशेषताओं के इतिहास का पता ही नहीं है। उनमें इसके प्रति जागरूकता एवं राष्ट्रीय चेतना पैदा करने का हमें पूरा प्रयास करना चाहिए। ताकि वो भी अपनी महान गौरवशाली परंपरा और संस्कृति को जानकर उस पर गर्व कर सकें। कौन-कौन से कारण रहे भारत के खण्ड-खण्ड होने के। एक बहुत महत्वपूर्ण कारण रहा जो आज भी विदेशी हमारे खिलाफ अपनाते रहते हैं, वह है फूट डालो और राज करो। पूर्व प्रधानमंत्री एवं भारतीय जनता पार्टी के पुरोधा अटल जी की एक कविता याद आती हैं—“दिन दूर नहीं, खंडित भारत को पुनः अखंड बनाएंगे, गिलगित से गारो पर्वत पर तिरंगा झंडा फहराएंगे।”

अखंड भारत राजनीतिक रूप से अभी संभव हो न हो, पर सांस्कृतिक रूप से भारत का स्वरूप काफी व्यापक है। भारतवर्ष का अखंड होना उसकी नियति है। परंतु वर्तमान समय में भारत के अनेक टुकड़े हो गए हैं जिनमें से सबसे बड़ा टुकड़ा इंडिया है, बाकी अनेक पर भारत की आत्मा एक है अतः भारत का अखंड होना पक्का है।



भारत आध्यात्मिक, नैतिक, बौद्धिक और कलात्मक रूप से न जाने कितना ही विविधताओं से भरा है। अनेकता में एकता का प्रतीक एक विशाल देश है। भारत का पतन इसलिए हुआ कि लोगों का जीवन अधार्मिक, अहंकारी, स्वार्थी और भौतिक हो गया। एक ओर अत्यधिक बाह्याचार, कर्मकांड, पूजापाठ में हम सभी लोग भटक गए तो दूसरी ओर अत्यधिक पलायन, वैराग्य की भावना, सब कुछ मोहमाया है में उलझ गये, जिसने समाज की सर्वोत्तम प्रतिभाओं को अपनी ओर आकृष्ट कर लिया जो लोग आध्यात्मिक समाज के जीवनदाता बन सकते थे, वे समाज के लिए मृत हो गए।

गीता हमारी राष्ट्रीय धरोहर है अतः इससे प्रेरणा लेकर हमें शक्ति की साधना और देशभक्ति की भावना बढ़ानी चाहिए। अखंड भारत के प्राचीन समय के अविभाजित स्वरूप को कहा जाता है। प्राचीन काल में भारत बहुत विस्तृत था। जम्बूद्वीप के नाम से ख्याति प्राप्त एशिया महाद्वीप हिंदू भारत ही था। आक्रमण होते गए हम सिकुड़ते गए। क्योंकि हम मानवीय मूल्यों वाले लोग थे। अखंड भारत में अफगानिस्तान, पाकिस्तान, बांग्लादेश, श्रीलंका, नेपाल, तिब्बत, भूटान, ब्रह्म देश (बर्मा), इन्डोनेशिया, कम्बोडिया, थाइलैंड आदि देश शामिल थे। कुछ देश जो बहुत पहले के समय में अलग हो चुके थे वही पाकिस्तान-बांग्लादेश आदि अंग्रेजों से स्वतंत्रता के काल में अलग हुए। अखंड भारत महज सपना नहीं, श्रद्धा नहीं निष्ठा है।

उसकी रज को माथे से लगाता हो, वंदेमातरम् जिनका राष्ट्र घोष और राष्ट्रगान हो, ऐसे व्यक्ति मातृभूमि के विभाजन की वेदना को कैसे भूल सकते हैं। अखंड भारत के संकल्प को कैसे त्याग सकते हैं? किंतु लक्ष्य के शिखर पर पहुँचने के लिए सच की कंटोली-पथरीली, कहीं काँटे तो कहीं दलदल,

कहीं गहरी खाई तो कहीं रपटीली चढ़ाई से होकर गुजरना ही होगा।

भारत की अखंडता का अर्थ क्या है? यदि कोई भौगोलिक मानचित्र है जिसे हम अखंड देखना चाहते हैं तो प्रश्न उठेगा कि उसकी सीमाएँ क्या हैं? क्या हम ब्रिटिश भारत की अखंडता चाहते हैं? १९४७ का विभाजन पहला और अंतिम विभाजन नहीं था। भारत की सीमाओं का बंटना उसके बहुत पहले से ही शुरू हो चुका था। सातवीं से नवीं शताब्दी तक लगभग ढाई सौ साल तक अकेले संघर्ष करके हिंदू अफगानिस्तान इस्लाम के पेट में समा गया। हिमालय की गोद में बसे नेपाल, भूटान आदि अपनी जटिल भौगोलिक स्थिति के कारण अविजित रह गए।

भारत की अखंडता का आधार भूगोल से ज्यादा संस्कृति और इतिहास में है। खंडित भारत में एक सशक्त, तेजोमयी राष्ट्र जीवन खड़ा करके ही अखंड भारत के लक्ष्य की ओर बढ़ना संभव होगा।

SARDAR VALLABHBHAI PATEL'S DREAMS

India is a large country with an amazing wealth of diversity. India, the opal which shines not less than a ruby has been teaching a lot to the whole world. Every citizen of our country naturally dreams of what kind of a country he or she desires. But dreams don't come true just by dreaming them. Someone must walk that extra mile to bring revolutions to the country. Out of the many jewels that mother India has given birth to, one is the legendary iron man of India, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. He must have given his blood, sweat and tears for making his dream come true. His dream was more than just to see India as one single landmass. According to him, a country is not just a landmass with its institutions but a country is its citizens which form its foundation to overcome any barrier. So, his foremost dream was to reunite the scattered India.

Indians were able to see the strength of unity when Sardar Patel joined Gandhiji in representing the weavers in the dispute with mill-owners in Ahmedabad in 1918, when he played a pivotal role in helping to redress the grievances of peasants in Kheda district. In 1928, Bardoli Taluka in Gujarat suffered from floods and famine. In this period of distress, the colonial British government raised the revenue by thirty per cent. During this time, Patel took up cudgels on behalf of the farmers and appealed to the Government to reduce the taxes. Initially, the government tried to repress the revolt but ultimately the government was bound to do the same and bowed before Vallabhbhai Patel. This victory in Bardoli caused intense excitement across large masses of people in India.



Following the Disobedience Movement in 1930, Patel was arrested and then released. With the release, he was elected as the Congress President in 1931 session in Karachi. In 1942, the INC launched the Quit India Movement following which he was arrested along with other freedom fighters and jailed for three years. Finally, the day came when India attained its freedom from the clutches of a long slavery of over 200 years of the British rule. It was a long and hard struggle in which many freedom fighters and great men laid their lives for our beloved motherland. After achieving Independence on 15th of August, 1947, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru became the first Prime Minister of independent India and Sardar Patel became the Deputy Prime Minister. He was in charge of Home Affairs, Information and Broadcasting and the Ministry of States. By the time, people realised that, Patel was the mesiah who was destined to reunite the whole country.

The Maharajas and Nawabs who ruled about 565 princely states in India at that time were drunk with wealth and power. They were dreaming of becoming independent rulers once the British quit India. They argued the idea of reunion. But, with great wisdom and political foresight, Patel was able to consolidate the small kingdoms. The hoi polloi were with him. He tackled the likes of Nizam of Hyderabad and the Nawab of Junagarh who initially did not want to join India. There were a lot of problems connected with the reunion of the numerous states into India. Sardar Patel's untiring efforts towards the unity of the country brought success. Due to the achievement of the massive task, Sardar Patel got the title of Iron Man. He is one of the prestigious leaders of the world who became immortal by uniting a scattered nation without any bloodshed. For his services to the nation, Sardar Patel was conferred with the Bharat Ratna Award in 1991 posthumously.

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel was able to fulfill his dream to a great extent. But, as we know

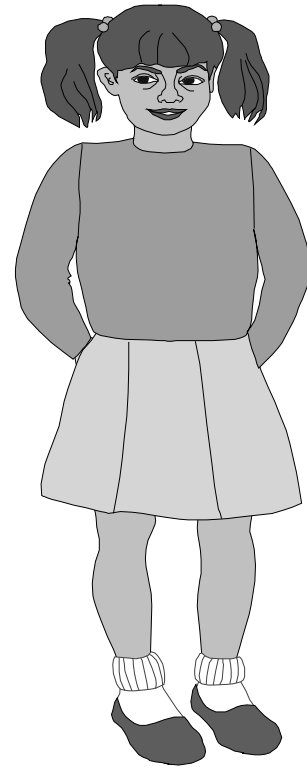

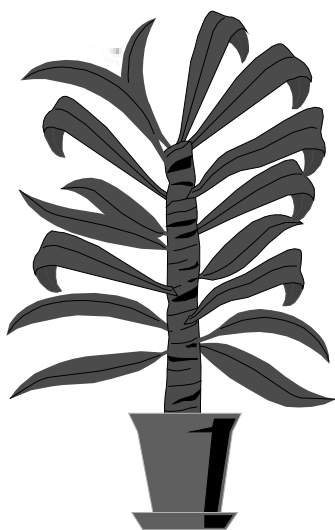

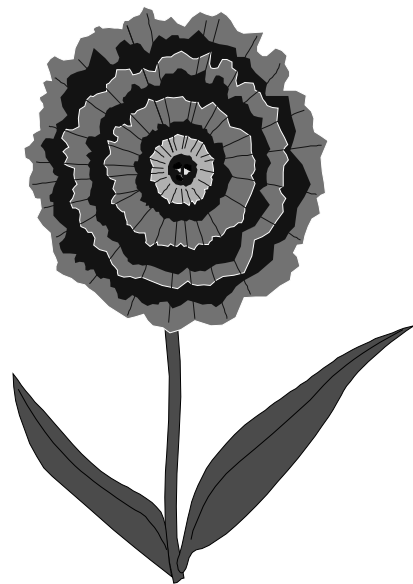

ISRO

ISRO, the Indian Space Research Organisation is the space agency of the government of India headquartered in the city of Bengaluru. The formation of ISRO was on 15th August 1969. The “God father” of ISRO was Vikram Sarabhai. ISRO built India’s first satellite, Aryabhata, which was launched by the Soviet Union on 19 April 1975. It was named after the mathematician Aryabhat. In 1980, Rohini became the first satellite to be placed in orbit by an Indian made launch vehicle, SLV-3. ISRO subsequently developed two other rockets: the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) for launching satellites into Polar orbits and the Geosynchronous satellite launch vehicle for placing satellites into geostationary orbits. These rockets have launched numerous communications satellite navigation system like GAGAN and IRNSS have been deployed. In January 2014, ISRO used an indigenous cryogenic engine in a GSLV-D5 launch of the GSAT-14. ISRO sent a lunar orbiter, Chandrayan-1 on 22 October 2008 which discovered lunar water in the form of ice, and the Mars orbiter Mission, on 5 November 2013, which entered Mars orbit on 24 September 2014, making India the first nation to succeed on its maiden attempt to Mars, as well as the first space agency in Asia to reach Mars orbit. On 18 June 2016, ISRO launched twenty satellite in a single rocket and on 15 February 2017, ISRO launched one hundred and four satellites in a single rocket. A world record.



ISRO launched its heaviest rocket, Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle-MARK III (GSLV-MK-III), on 5 June 2017, and placed a communication satellite GSAT-19 in Orbit. With this launch, ISRO became capable of launching 4-ton heavy satellites into GTO. On 22 July 2019, ISRO launched its second lunar mission, Chandrayan-2 which consists of an orbiter, lander and rover, to study the lunar geology and the distribution of lunar water.

Future plans include development of the unified Launch vehicle, small satellite Launch vehicle, development of a reusable launch vehicle, human spaceflight, a space station, interplanetary probes and a solar spacecraft mission.

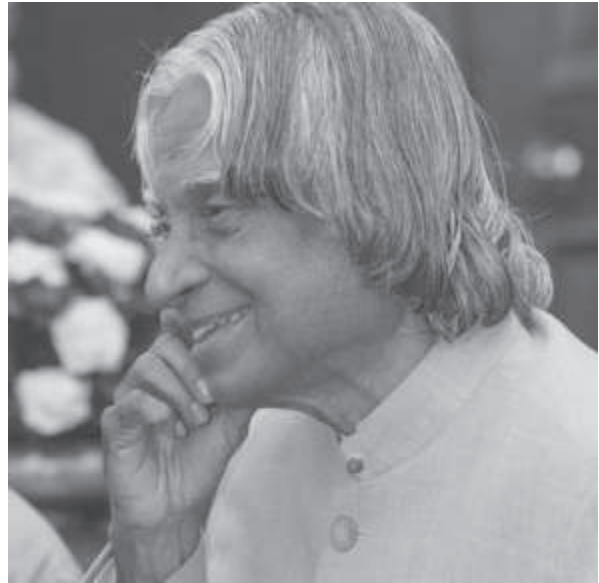

LIVING WITH PLASTICS OR DYING WITH IT?

Over the years, my mother and grandmother have been using big glass (jars) 'martbaan' to store pickles and salted lemons. We were barred to touch these jars, and were allowed only small servings on the dining table to savour tingling salivating glands.

Little I knew that glass jars, tumblers, bottle takes over thousand years to decompose. Soon, plastic containers took over the heavy, delicate, clay and bottle containers of our kitchen; which were lighter, brighter, portable and non-reactive to our items. Later, items of Tupperware made our modular kitchens much tidier and neater.

Little I knew that this colourful cheaper, recycled handy plastic which is non-biodegradable will soon envelope our world with gloom and doom.

We and plastic became inseparable, beginning with toothbrush, bottles, pens, buckets, microwave bowls, melamine bakelite, disposable cutlery, polythene.... the list is neverending and the result is disastrous.

Little I knew that some of these single use plasticwares and plastic spoons, polythene takes around four hundred to five hundred years to degrade. The heaps and rounds that are dumped in water bodies leads to imbalance in aquatic eco-system. Those dumped on land leaches to ground and pollute the source of the drinking water, leads to many dreadful diseases. Drinking water in single use disposable bottles like that of soft drinks or fruit extracts or hot tea & coffee in plastic glasses may lead to cancer.

Swiggy or Zomato distributing hot edible items in aluminium foil or plastic containers dumped around us everywhere will soon turn a menace to our future generation.

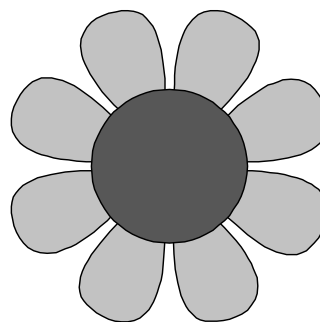
